Surface Cleaning				
1	Remove all dust and debris from the surface using a vacuum and tack cloth.			
2	Perform a water break test to check for grease or oil residues.			
3 Ensure all surfaces are dry and free from moisture before priming.				

Surface Defects					
4	Inspect for cracks and fill them with a suitable filler.				
5	Sand down any uneven areas to create a smooth surface.
