Precast Element Inspection	
1	Check the alignment of each precast element using a laser level; tolerance should not exceed 5 mm.
2 Verify that all connection points are secure and comply with engineering spec	
3	Inspect the surface finish of precast elements for any visible defects or cracks.

Tempor	Temporary Bracing Inspection	
4	Ensure temporary bracing is installed as per the design plan and is stable.	
5	Check that bracing materials are free from defects and are adequately anchored.	
6	Confirm that bracing supports are not obstructing other construction activities.	

Safety Equipment and Procedures		
7	Ensure all lifting equipment has been inspected and certified for use.	
8 Verify that all personnel are wearing appropriate personal protective equipment (
9	Review the lifting plan to ensure all procedures are followed to mitigate risks.	

Documentation and Sign-Off	
10	Ensure all inspection records are completed and signed by the responsible engineer.
Document any deviations or issues found during the inspection and report to site management.	
12	Ensure a final sign-off is completed once all elements are securely installed and braced.
